Uses

How it Works

The active ingredient in Wondercide Flea & Tick products is cedar oil, which has been used for centuries to protect from pests (think Grandma's cedar chest!). Cedar oil works by blocking octopamine, which is necessary to regulate heart rate, movement, and metabolism in "bad bugs" like fleas and ticks. When cedar oil is present in the area, pests are repelled. When contacted by cedar oil, pests die.

To eliminate an **active** flea or tick problem, treat outdoor areas twice in 7 days at an 8 oz dilution to break the egg layer cycle. For ongoing **prevention**, treat every 30-45 days, or as needed, for best results. Year-round use enhances results. For pet bedding and laundry, use 2 oz per load, with laundry soap.
